

**For all counsel with hearings scheduled before the Honorable Mark A. Randon for Wednesday, March 18<sup>th</sup>:**

Please be advised that no formal status conferences or contested hearings will take place in Judge Randon's courtroom for Chapter 13 matters scheduled through April 13<sup>th</sup> pursuant to the Administrative Order of the Court issued today.

If you have not already been notified by our office that your matter is confirmed or resolved, please seek concurrence of any objecting creditors and submit a proposed order adjourning the hearing to our office by the close of business today. I have been advised that the Court will approve all reasonable requests for adjournment agreed to by the Chapter 13 Trustee and any objecting parties by stipulation and proposed order.

Any unresolved matters which have not been adjourned by tomorrow will be scheduled for a formal telephonic hearing at 2 pm on Wednesday, March 18<sup>th</sup>, which will be initiated by the Court. The Chapter 13 Trustee may also contact the moving party by telephone at the normally scheduled status conference hour where issues remain outstanding or parties have failed to respond to prior emails. The published phone number for your office will be used unless you have specified another number in advance.

We ask for the assistance and cooperation of all debtors, creditors and attorneys in this process. The necessity for these changes has arisen quickly and the process for addressing them is still fluid. My staff and I are working to address these changes as quickly as possible while providing as much flexibility to all parties involved. Your patience and understanding is greatly appreciated.
