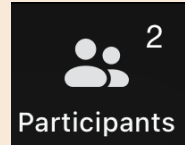

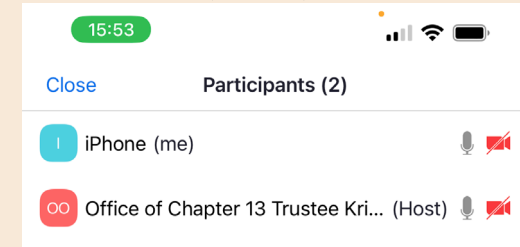

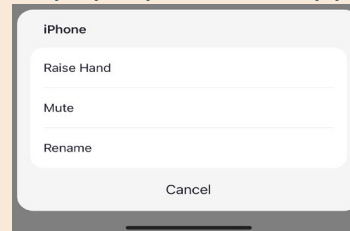


2 COMPUTER: HOVER OVER YOUR NAME THEN CLICK THE ELLIPSES ...

IN THE APP: TAP YOUR NAME (ME)



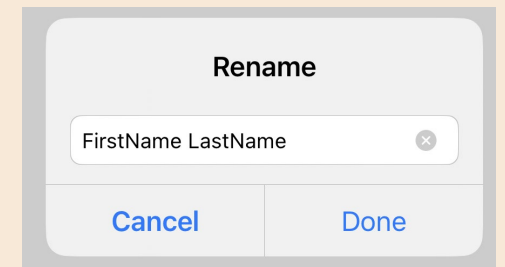
3 SELECT RENAME
A pop-up box will appear.

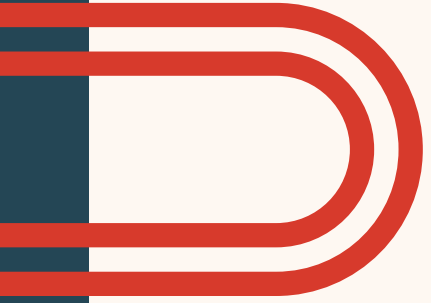
